New DENON AVR-2809 for advanced home theatre experience



Berlin, IFA 2008 – DENON today announced the availability of their new visionary upper class AV receiver AVR-2809. The new model adds to the successfully introduced middle and entry class models AVR-1509, 1709, 1909 and 2309 that already power several home cinemas and living rooms. DENON simply took their continuing effort to maximize the consumer's audio video experience at every price point and created a powerful control centre that plays between the middle class and high-end receivers for demanding but price conscious home theatre enthusiasts.

The AVR-2809 is equipped with decoders for next-generation audio formats such as the lossless audio Dolby TrueHD and DTS-HD Master Audio formats. It also features a high-performance Faroudja DCDi video processing circuitry that reproduces SD video material from DVD players and other sources in astonishing 1080p HD quality. DENON unique technologies like the D.D.S.C.-HD circuitry and AL24 Processing Plus make for the ultimate audio performance. Four HDMI 1.3a inputs with Deep Color support and several other digital and analog ports let the AVR-2809 manage all challenges of today's high-definition applications. A complete elaborate Audyssey sound equalizing package with MultEQ-XT, Dynamic Volume and Dynamic EQ adds perfection to the sound experience in every individual consumer listening environment, even in difficult situations. Advanced multi-zone support with variable pre-outs leaves nothing to be desired.

In addition, the AVR-2809 offers integration features such as dedicated iPod dock accessory control ports that provide command and control capability for iPods via the on-screen GUI and more. DENON just launched the iPod control dock ASD-11R (available in Black and White at a suggested retail price of EUR 99,-) that adds perfectly to the new powerful home entertainment center.

The AVR-2809 will go on sale in September 2008 at a suggested retail price of EUR 1.099,-. It is available in Premium Silver and Black to suit DENON's new advanced Blu-ray/DVD/CD Player line-up that has been introduced recently.
